

BOLIVIA RADIO PROJECT

In their home in eastern Bolivia, a family gathers around a radio to listen to messages that encourage them and lift their spirits. Programs, especially those in Low German, provide some relief from the day-to-day struggles.



The Radio del Campo Boliviano station in the city of San Jose is operated by MEM ministry staff and broadcasts the message of God's love and hope to a region that has an estimated 10,000 potential listeners in Mennonite colonies and additional thousands of mainly Spanish-speaking Bolivians in the area.



A new radio station project is underway in Nueva Estrella and a new radio tower has recently been constructed. Work is being done to outfit the studio and get programming on the air. Through this new project another estimated 30,000 Mennonite listeners may be reached as well as hundreds of thousands of Spanish speakers.
